




CROSSING OF SPATIAL, BUILDING AND MATERIAL CULTURE DATA

RESEARCH GOALS

- ❖ Evaluation of relational trends between functional categories and type of transformation (gradual or adaptive).
 - ❖ Calculation of the variation of the intensity of the spatial, building and material culture values from one chronology to another.
 - ❖ Identification of the type of resources accessible or used, in relation to the two classes of transformation (gradual or adaptive).
 - ❖ Creation of maps of variation of intensity to different spatial, building and material culture values.

- ❖ Evaluation of the type of transformation for a specific chronology in the different urban centers.
 - ❖ Global and diachronic reconstruction of changes in specific settlements, identifying adaptive transformations and gradual transformations.
 - ❖ Creation of maps of transformation in relation to specific settlements and chronology.
